

Dear Parents / Carers, 7th September 2018

A huge welcome back to everyone; especially all our new families who have joined us this new academic year. Just a few reminders regarding safeguarding:

- A letter has gone home for children in years 5/6 to walk home unaccompanied. If we do not have
 this signed slip please bear in mind we are unable to allow your child to leave the premises
 unaccompanied. Can any outstanding slips please be returned to class teachers or straight to the
 office.
- Parking Mr Earley and Miss Larner are our cone supervisors at the bottom of the drive at the beginning and end of the school day. Please think about the safety of everyone and do not park inappropriately. It is easier to park a little way away and walk.
- Attendance This is an area we need your help with more. If your child is absent we need to know by phone call or email. If we do not hear from you by 9:30am, office staff will be chasing this up. If we have any concerns we now have to report to the Education Welfare Service straight away. Remember registration is at 8:45am. Even minutes late can affect your child's learning. We will continue to monitor this throughout the year.

Today your children will have brought home a number of forms including data sheets, annual trip consent forms and home school agreements. We would really appreciate it if these could be signed and returned to school by Friday 14th September.
