

Dear Parents / Carers, 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2017

I can't believe we are at the end of week 3 already!

Some reminders for everybody:

- When your child is absent from school, <u>as well as</u> ringing in before 9:30 to tell us your child will not be in school, we also require a written note stating the reason for absences within three days of returning to school. Proformas are available at the gate every morning or from the office at any time. If written notification is not received within 3 days then the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. As a school we will be continuing to working very closely with the Educational Welfare services, our Educational Welfare officer will be coming in to school on a monthly basis to check registers, just as last year during this time she will be looking closely at total attendance for each child, patterns of attendance, as well as lateness. Lateness affects your child's learning greatly and can also disrupt the rest of the class learning as well. If there is any persistent patterns already forming this term for either absences or lateness, they will be picking this up.
- If anyone else is collecting your child from school, the class teacher or office **must** be informed. If we have not had confirmation from yourselves, we are unable to let your child leave the premises until you have been contacted.
- We advise all children to bring their PE kit in to school on a Monday so that is in school ready for their PE lessons and take it home on a Friday. We are monitoring children who continually forget their PE kit.
- After the October half term, the price of breakfast club will be rising to £2 per child, per session.
- There will not be a Celebration Worship next Friday (29<sup>th</sup> September) as the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra are visiting the children. The first one will be Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October.

This year's Harvest Festival will be taking place on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October. We will be having a whole school assembly from 2:00pm, it would be lovely to see lots of you there. As always we are collecting donations for the Isle of Wight food bank; if you have any boxed or tinned foods at home you can donate that would be fantastic, the food bank is a very worthy cause that helps lots of families island-wide. Also, on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October it is the Horticultural show at the Brading town hall. All the children have been working very hard on their entries and these will be displayed throughout the day. We will be taking the children down to view their work.

Finally, thank you to everyone who has returned completed data forms and annual ev3 forms. Can all remaining forms please be returned via the class teachers or direct to Miss Hughes on Monday. It's really important that we get the EV3's back as there are various trips coming up. Thank you.
