

Dear Parents / Carers, 17th November 2017

On Monday we had our anti-bullying day in school where children came in wearing odd socks and shoes, thank you to everyone who supported us in recognising that everyone is different. The children had a great day; across the school they all did different work on anti-bullying including looking at our anti-bullying charter and slogan 'Be a Buddy not a Bully'. They also shared stories with each other in their house teams. As a school team we do not tolerate bullying in any form and know that you support us in this - we have provided an information sheet to help with bullying which we have also added to the website under the 'Safeguarding' section. Remember my door is always open to all parents, carers and children to discuss any concerns which can be sorted out straight away.

Banksy class were our last class to visit Osborne House on Wednesday, they had a brilliant time. It has been fantastic to have all the children from year 1 to year 6 visit and undertake the same trip.

Next week we are having road safety week in school where the children will be taking part in different activities to promote road safety and awareness. This year's theme is 'Speed Down Save Lives'. It's really important that the children learn this as our school is close to a very busy road, and not all drivers adhere to the 20mph restriction.
