Welcome back, especially to our new families who have joined us! I hope you all had a fabulous summer break and are refreshed ready for the new academic year. It has been amazing to see the children settling into their new classes so quickly. I would just like to remind you of a few things to keep in mind for the new academic year:

- Make sure **everything** is labelled, including uniform, PE Kit, lunch boxes, water bottles, school bags. This is to ensure that nothing goes missing or goes home with the wrong child.
- Water bottles should be brought in daily, we have a water cooler in school where children can top up their bottles during the day,
- We are a **nut free school**. Please do not send in any products in your child's lunchbox that contain nuts as we have children and staff with severe allergies.
- Parents / carers / relatives are invited in on Friday's for Celebration Worship. During this assembly we present children who have achieved Star of the Week and Best Work with a certificate, and celebrate birthdays. You will get a text message on a Thursday if your child is receiving a certificate, inviting you to come along. Assemblies are open to all. Children in Foundation Stage start joining Friday assemblies after half term.

Data sheets have been sent home today for you to check the records which we hold for your children and lots of other letters have been sent home this week, can I ask that you please return any outstanding forms as quickly as possible. Especially the annual ev3 consent form for offsite visits which we need before we can take your child(ren) out for school visits even if you have already returned the permission slip for the specific trip.

Children in years 3 and 4 will have their first swimming lesson on Monday morning at the Waterside swimming pool in Ryde. Please ensure that they have the necessary swimming kit with them so they can join in.

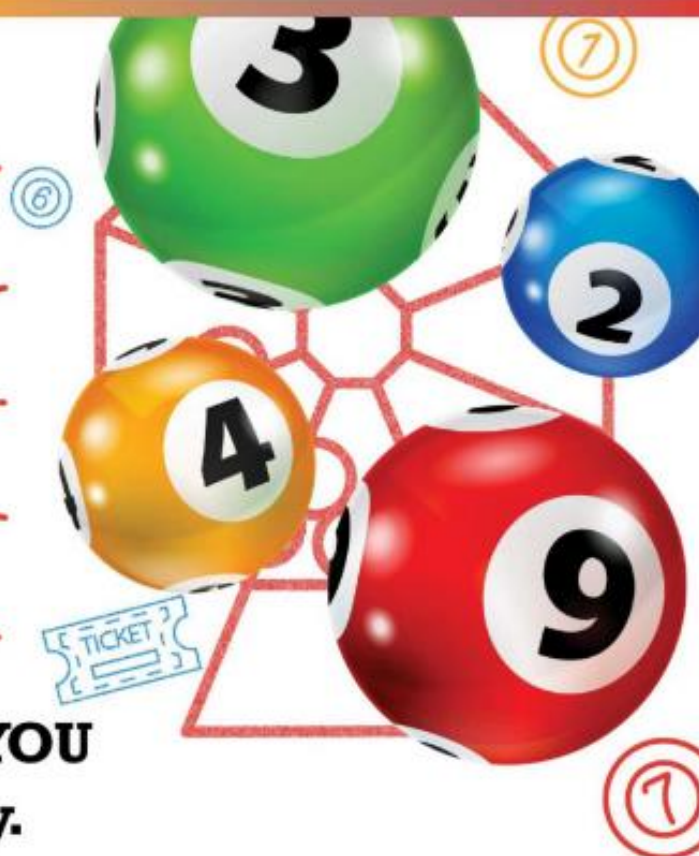

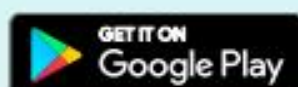
