Walk to School Week

Sickness/diarrhoea

Can I just remind you that we follow the 48-hour rule for sickness and diarrhoea – **children must stay off school until 48 hours after the last bout of sickness and/or diarrhoea.** When you call in the morning to advise us of your child's absence a member of office staff can advise you when your child can return to school. As a team we should be supporting each other and working together, please don't embarrass us by asking you to collect your child and take them home. Thank you for your support.

Bees

Don't worry if you notice a lot of bee activity in the walls between the office and the courtyard where the children are collected at the end of the day. They visit us every year and a bee expert advised us that they are in fact a mock bee (hairy footed flower bees – anthophora plumipes) and they are totally harmless and cannot sting. They will only be around for 3-4 weeks whilst they lay their eggs and will then be gone, we may see them again in September when the eggs hatch!

Next week we will be having an Internet safety day where all the children will learn about the importance of being safe online. Our day to day lives are filled with technology and it is super important for children to learn both the dangers of being online and how to deal with things they may come across. As adults we should also be aware of what sites our children are using and have the correct parental restrictions in place so that they cannot access anything they shouldn't be.






