

Dear Parents/Carers 2nd July 2021

I can't believe that after today there are only 13 more school days to go. Just to remind you once again that the children now finish for the summer on **Wednesday 21**st **July.**

School reports

Next Friday you will be receiving your child's school report for the academic year. There will be an opportunity the following week to speak to your child's class teacher if you have any questions in regards to the report. I would just like to thank the whole teaching team for their hard work this year. Invites will be sent next week. If you are happy with the report then you do not need to sign up, if you have any queries then please do sign up.

Next academic year – staffing

I will be letting you know next week where teaching staff will be in September. All children will have the opportunity to spend 3 days with their new class teachers in the last week of term like we did last year. We will also provide a social story and photos if required.

School day and staggered start times

Following the parent/carer questionnaire that was sent out earlier in the term, the overwhelming response was that the vast majority felt the start times were beneficial, especially now our numbers have increased. Therefore, from September the school day for key stages will be:

- EYFS / KS1 8:30/8:35 2:35
- KS2 8:25/8:30 2:30

Entrances from September will be:

- EYFS Side entrance
- KS1 Front entrance
- KS2 (Year 5 and Year 3) Front entrance
 KS2 (Year 6 and Year 4) Side entrance

Lunches

Our aim is to have a full dinner menu back up and running in September, which will still need to be ordered in advance. Lunch boxes will need to be washable plastic.

Book bags

More information will follow on this before the end of term. No more books will come home after next week.

We will continue with children wearing these on the days they have PE and for fun clubs. (No p.e kits will be needed in school)

Breakfast club

Breakfast club will now start at 7:45am. Please note that from September the cost will be raising to £2.50 per child per session.

Fun club

These will start during the third week of next term and will run for 10 weeks. They will incur a cost; we will inform you of this next term. To book a space, you will need to pay in advance. For those children who are listed as pupil premium the costing will be different.

Wrap around care

Our aim, if viable, is to try and start this in September. If you have not sent in your reply can we please have this by Monday 5th July at the latest.

Class photos

We will be taking class photos ourselves this year. We will be putting them on the front office window next week and then you can sign up after that.

Transfer for year 6

Mr Barnes will be in contact in regards to a virtual leavers assembly and for the end of year trips.

Sports day

Remember this will take place in September, so that we can do it as a whole school team.

- mild forms of violence (non-realistic or with no detail)

PEGI 12

Games with a PEGI 12 rating are suitable for ages 12 and above.

They may have:

- violence of a slightly graphic nature involving fantasy characters
- suggestive activities or language
- gambling
- mild bad language

PEGI 16

Games with a PEGI 16 rating are suitable for ages 16 and above.

They may have:

- violence and adult content that looks like real life
- bad language
- the use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs
