THIS WEEK AT BRADING...

Maldives

In year 1 this week we have started addition. We have been using different methods and concrete resources to help which the children have been enjoying. In English we have been writing a prediction for the book 'Mr Wolf and the Enormous Turnip', using colourful semantic sentence builders to help us. In PSHE we are still learning about our different feelings, how to recognise these and what we can do to help us feel better when we are in the red/ yellow or blue zones.

Malta

This week has been another fantastic week in Malta class. We have finished our narrative in English which has developed our understanding on the Stone Age. We have also completed our R.E day which has been focused around trees. To finish the week, we completed our science topic for the term and spent this week recognising how plants pollinate.

Antigua

In Antigua this week we have been investigating Harvest alongside St Lucia. We have been listening to harvest stories and songs. In phonics this week we have been exploring voice sounds through sound bags and songs. Then in maths we have been exploring size further and investigating patterns. We made patterns using vegetable prints. We have been practicing our harvest song and we have made the last large fruits and vegetables for our song, with St Lucia. We have been practicing hard. The children appeared to really enjoy using different puppets this term to retell stories and in choice play have continued to act out their own stories. Iceland

This week in Iceland class, we have been completing our topic on Romans by learning about Roman gods, printing Roman mosaics in art and going on our trip to Brading Roman Villa. We have finished our maths unit on decimal fractions and have learnt about Jane Goodall in science.

Galapagos

Galapagos have spent their history lesson learning all about Viking runes and creating their own Viking rune tiles. They have also worked extremely hard in DT recreating the Isle of Berk from our text driver, How to Train Your Dragon!

Cuba

This week in Cuba Class, we painted our own coat of arms using sponges on paint to print. We have also had fun exploring the laptops and creating our own pictures of castle, knights and dragons using a painting app. We all worked really hard on our pictures and they look fantastic.



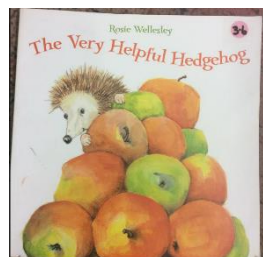
Hawaii

We also used our fingers to finger-paint Autumn leaves onto our trees.



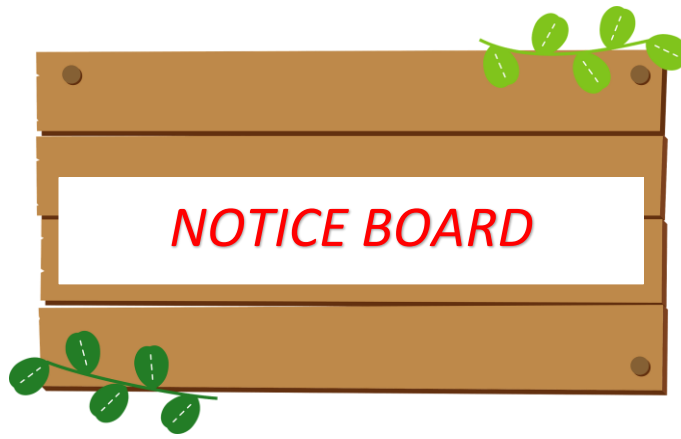
New Zealand

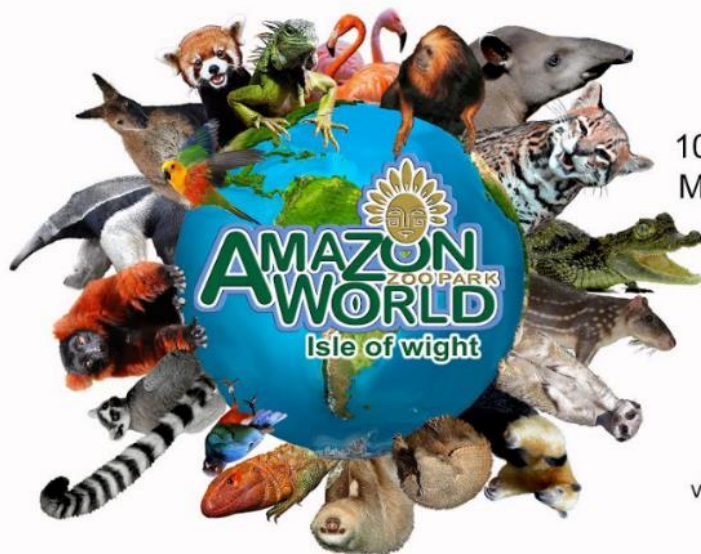
